

Chrysanthemum Temari Class

The 16 point chrysanthemum (Kiku) is perhaps the quintessential temari design. Although it represents a flower, any and all color combinations are acceptable.

The supplies needed for this project are:

- 4" ball wrapped with thread. If you want to purchase one from Robin **you must pre-order a specific color by 9/1.** Cost will be \$14.
- Perle 5 cotton in three or more colors. Be sure to consider contrast when selecting your colors.
- Kreinik #12 metallic thread for marking guidelines and accents.

Marking for this pattern is a simple 16.



Be sure to bring needles, scissors, paper measuring strips, plenty of pins and small pliers if you have them.
