

**Cranes and Bamboo
Temari Class**

**February 3rd, 2018 at Thistle Needleworks
10:00 am - 1:00 pm**



This is a traditional New Year design. It is created using a combination of wrapped bands and layered spindles to represent bamboo. The cranes are stitched with a technique very similar to the Dragonflies pattern.

The supplies needed for this project are:

- 4" ball wrapped with thread (bring your own or buy one for \$14.)
- Perle 5 cotton in three shades of "bamboo" color plus white, black and red. Splendor Silk (stranded) will also work for the bamboo and Caron Collection "Snow" is good for the white cranes.
- Thin metallic or other thread for marking guidelines in a color that matches the background thread layer.

Marking for this pattern is a simple 12.

You may wish to bring your 12 divisions instructions and grid from previous lessons (Hidden Blossom and Snowflakes) or place the pins before class.

Be sure to bring needles, scissors, paper measuring strips, plenty of pins and a tape measure that has metric measurements on one side.
