This pattern is another one where the flower shapes are actually the negative space outlined by stitching. Layers of interwoven and overlapping stitching look much more complicated than it really is.

The supplies needed for this project are:

- 3" ball wrapped with thread (bring your own or buy one for \$8.) Remember, the flowers will be the color of the thread wrap.
- Perle 5 cotton in one solid or variegated color. Also, yellow for the centers. Be sure to consider contrast when selecting your colors.
- Kreinik #12 metallic thread for marking guidelines and accents is optional.

Marking for this pattern is a C-8.

Be sure to bring needles, scissors, paper measuring strips, plenty of pins.
