

Hidden Blossom Temari Class

This pattern uses the basic “Kiku” stitch in a completely different way. It is basically two stitching paths that overlap at the equator to form diamond shapes but the remaining negative space at each pole is a beautiful flower!

The supplies needed for this project are:

- 3” ball wrapped with thread (bring your own or buy one for \$8.) Remember, the flowers will be the color of the thread wrap.
- Perle 5 cotton in four colors. Be sure to consider contrast when selecting your colors. A variegated thread can work well in this design.
- Kreinik #12 metallic thread for marking guidelines and accents.

Marking for this pattern is a simple 12.

Be sure to bring needles, scissors, paper measuring strips, plenty of pins.
