

This is a pretty and versatile pattern that teaches the basic "Kiku" stitch which is used to create the chrysanthemum and many other floral designs. It is a fundamental temari technique that has so many variations.

The supplies needed for this project are:

- 3" ball wrapped with thread (bring your own or buy one for \$8.)
- Perle 5 cotton in three or more colors. Be sure to consider contrast when selecting your colors.
- Kreinik #12 metallic thread for marking guidelines and accents.

Marking for this pattern is a simple eight.

Be sure to bring needles, scissors, paper measuring strips, plenty of pins and small pliers if you have them.
