

Snowflake Temari Class

December 2nd at Thistle Needleworks
10:00 am - 1:00 pm



This is a festive holiday design that offers the opportunity to use all kinds of pretty sparkles. Stitch it with your favorite white thread on a 3" base. Any dark or strong background color will provide contrast so that the snowflake design really pops.

The supplies needed for this project are:

- 3" ball wrapped with thread (bring your own or buy one for \$8.) Remember, the snowflakes need a dark or bright background.
- White metallic or iridescent thread (like "Snow" from Caron Collection)
- Perle 5 cotton in 1 or 2 colors for the Obi
- Kreinik #12 or other metallic thread for marking guidelines.
- Beads, sequins or crystals are optional additions.

Marking for this pattern is a S-12.

Be sure to bring needles, scissors, paper measuring strips, plenty of pins.

Special Bonus!

We will learn an easy way to make beautiful flowing tassels to embellish finished temari and how to attach hanging cords.

You will need 2 skeins of DMC metallic floss and a few feet of matching kreinik for each tassel.
