

Swirling Dragonflies Temari

This is an attractive pattern that is fairly easy to stitch featuring eight dragonflies swirling around in all directions. Any color scheme you like will look good as long as you remember to use strong contrast.

The supplies needed for this project are:

- 3" ball wrapped with thread (bring your own or buy one from Robin for \$8.)
- Perle 5 or similar thread in a color that very closely matches the ball for applying inconspicuous guidelines.
- Metallic threads for the dragonflies themselves. You can use #12 or a slightly heavier metallic like a #16 or even a 1/16th ribbon. The bodies can match or contrast the wings.
- Very fine metallic to accent the wings.
- Small beads (16 of them) for eyes or you can do French knots instead.

Bring your needles, scissors, tape measure, pins, eyeglasses, etc.
